## 2. New features, modifications and history

### **LANconfig modifications from 5.00.0011 -> 5.02.0003** **LANmonitor modifications from 5.00.0017 -> 5.02.0001**

#### **Corrections/modifications:**

##### **LANconfig:**

- Using LANconfig on a device with a firmware less than 2.20, the configuration password will now be stored properly
- The WAN interface status on ADSL devices will now be indicated correctly

##### **LANmonitor:**

- reduced memory usage

### **LANconfig modifications from 4.20.0022 -> 5.00.0011** **LANmonitor modifications from 4.20.0014 -> 5.00.0017**

#### **New features:**

##### **LANconfig:**

- support for scripting functionality
- accesspoints can be combined and configured in a group.
- configured connections can be deleted from the router using the Delete-wizard

##### **LANmonitor:**

- display of CPU- and memory load
- display of temperature at LANCOM 8011 VPN, LANCOM 7111 VPN and LANCOM OAP-54 Wireless

##### **WLANmonitor:**

- accesspoints and clients can be monitored better with WLANmonitor.

#### **Corrections/modifications:**

##### **LANmonitor:**

- opening LANmonitor restores the last used tree view
