## 1. Preface

LCMS, consisting of LANconfig and LANmonitor, serves for the administration of all Wireless LAN Access Points and Routers. The at a time latest versions are available for all LANCOM products. You can download it for free at <http://www.lancom-systems.com>

This document describes the innovations within version 9.00 Rel, as well as the modifications since version 8.84.

### **Note**

LCMS supports Windows Vista, Windows 7, Windows 8, Windows 2003 Server, Windows 2008 Server, Windows Server 2011 (all 32- and 64-bit versions) and Windows Server 2012 & Windows Server 2012 R2.

As from version 8.50 the paths for user data and application data have changed.

In Windows XP and Windows 2003 Server you will find user data under \Documents and Settings\USER\Application Data\LANCOM\ and the application files under \Documents and Settings\All Users\Application Data\LANCOM\.

For Windows Vista and Windows 2008 Server you will find user data under \Users\USER\AppData\Roaming\LANCOM\ and the application files under \ProgramData\LANCOM\.

When upgrading to version 8.50 or newer existing user data and application data are moved to the corresponding folders.

As from LCMS 9.00 the support for Windows XP is discontinued. However, LCMS can still be installed, but this operating system is no longer tested and supported by LANCOM

##### LANconfig:

- Configurable DFS behaviour

- Improvements for SSH access
- L2TP remote stations can no longer be selected from the IPv6 routing table
- DS-Lite via ethernet can be configured via setup wizard again
- The setup wizard for VPN client dial-in with user-defined parameters offers PFS groups 14, 15 and 16

**New Features:**

**LANconfig:**

- WLAN key fields are treated like password fields
- CAPWAP can be disabled on a WLC
- Simplified AutoWDS configuration
- Name length for Point to Point connections extended to 24 characters
- Setup Wizard extended by some internet service providers
- Configurable management ports
- WLAN key fields are treated as password fields and no longer readable in clear text
- Switchable LLDP
- Configurable L2TP
- Special commands are possible via SSH (e.g. device restart, software option upload, set time)
- Extended the internet setup wizard by DS-Lite

**(W)LANmonitor:**

- An error state is displayed on the upper level of the corresponding tree
- Added vectoring state to the VDSL status display
- LANmonitor shows AutoWDS topology
- PRP connection information display (Parallel Redundancy Protocol)
- WTP reallocation can be initialized via LANmonitor
- Each LANmonitor treeview item can be copied to the clipboard using STRG+C
- If an error occurs it will be shown at the corresponding item
- The (W)LANmonitor can monitor LANCOM devices via IPv6
- Active and inactive Public Spot users are shown in LANmonitor

- Improved error management when writing faulty device configurations
- Improvements for the Public Spot wizard
- Improved dialogs and help for the CRON table
- A locked PIN can be unlocked from within LANconfig
- If a logical WLAN profile is created via WLC setup wizard, the requested SSID is applied correctly
- Volume budget settings are only configurable if supported by the device
- No application crash when importing CSV files containing wrong separator characters
- No faulty display when maximizing the LANtracer window
- An error message is displayed if the LANtracer module cannot connect to the LANCOM device
- Improved configuration upload via SSH
- Accesspoint groups can be refreshed without getting an error message
- Refreshing a device can be done using WLANmonitor's system menu
- If a VPN client is configured with the setup wizard, the proposals are correctly set when using user-defined parameters
- Modified input fields for Ipv6 addresses
- Added missing default values to offline configurations

**(W)LANmonitor:**

- LANconfig can be invoked from LANmonitor
- Similar functions in WLANmonitor for context- and program menu
- Empty groups / folders are still displayed in the folder tree after restarting the application
- Completed WLANmonitor menu for english language
